# Message from Cllr Anil Saini, Chairman of Ketley Parish Council

"It was reassuring to see so many residents at our recent meeting with Superintendent Nav Malik, Detective Chief Inspector Jennie Mattinson and Chief Inspector James Baker from West Mercia Police who attended the meeting to answer questions from concerned residents on the number of burglaries in the Parish. It was also reassuring to hear that the number of burglaries is lower in Ketley than in other parts of the Borough and that nationally, Telford has a lower crime rate. Residents were reminded of the simplest things to deter burglars: to keep their properties locked and their belongings out of sight when they are at work or away on holiday. On behalf of the Parish Council, I would like to thank West Mercia Police for offering to meet with the residents of Ketley and listening to their concerns." Clir Anil Saini.

The Parish Council is in the process of appointing a new contractor and in the interim wants to reassure residents that there will be no change to standards. ### Changes to the Electoral Boundaries in Telford

Following a recent Local Government Boundary Commission review on ward boundaries in Telford & Wrekin, the borough council are to implement changes to ward boundaries in time for the anticipated 2015 elections. Ketley will form a new 3-member ward with Overdale, named Ketley & Overdale Ward. Further details are available from the Parish Clerk.

### Rooms Available for Hire at Ketley Community Centre

Ketley Community Centre has rooms available to hire for an hourly cost of £12.50 per hour with discounts for charities. There is a large hall ideal for birthday parties and sporting activities, an Art Room with a sink area, a fully equipped IT suite with internet access and free wi-fi, a formal meeting room with flip chart and projector and a classroom with a linked kitchen ideal for courses and training events. ### Resurfacing of Woodside Road, Ketley

Telford & Wrekin Council Highway Department has informed the Parish Council that Woodside Road will be resurfaced during the week commencing 14 April 2014. Traffic diversions are in place – details can be found on the Parish noticeboards at Ketley Community Centre.

### **Rights of Way in Ketley**

Ketley Parish Council have worked closely with Telford & Wrekin Council to identify those rights of way throughout the Parish that were in a desperate need of clearing. This work is near completion and I hope that you see an improvement. If there are footpaths that you feel still need to be cleared, please contact the Parish Clerk.

### Streetlight Replacement Programme

As previously reported, Ketley Parish Council has committed £25k towards upgrading streetlights throughout the Parish in desperate need of repair or replacement. This programme begins in May 2014. As part of this programme, the Parish Council also looked into ways of reducing electricity costs for streetlighting and as from April 2014 will replace faulty lights with LED lights.

## 2014-15 Precept

At the Ketley Parish Council meeting on 9 January 2014 councillors unanimously voted not to increase their annual budget received from Telford & Wrekin Council. The annual budget (Precept) received is funded via Council Tax payments from residents in the Parish. This decision means that you do not have an increase to your Council Tax contribution to the Parish Council. In 2014-15 the Parish Council will receive a precept of £114, 484 from Telford & Wrekin Council.

## Changes to Recycling Services

As from 1 April 2014 Veolia Environmental Services will be taking over the contract for kerbside recycling. A new purple wheelie bin will be provided to all households for the recycling of cans, plastic and glass. Residents must continue to use the blue box and/or blue bag for the recycling of paper and card. To recycle textiles, use a carrier bag and place it next to your purple bin.
